- Entry Fee is \$50.00 for the first class, and \$35.00 for each additional class (3 classes maximum). There will be no refunds (with the exception of entries received after the 400 entry limitation reached). **Check or money order should be made out to the Flying Dutchmen Motorcycle Club.**
- Gate Entry Fee is \$10.00 per day and \$15.00 for a weekend pass. This is not included in the entry fee and will be collected upon your arrival.
- All riders must be AMA members in good standing with a current AMA card.
- Participant under 18 years of age must provide a notarized letter of consent with the entry form and provide a notarized copy of their birth certificate.
- Rider order will be determined by the date the entry is received. First entry rides last, last entry rides first.
- Tech Inspection will be on Friday, August 14th, 2009, starting at 8:30 am. **Mandatory** Riders meeting will be at 5 pm on Friday, August 14th. All participants **MUST** attend both the tech inspection and riders meeting. No entry tech inspections will be allowed after Friday.
- There will a pork chop supper provided free to the entrants and \$5.00 per person to the pit crew/family/others Friday evening after the riders meeting.
- Credit Card processing will not be available at the event.

Supplementary Rules

All rules will be followed according to the 2009 AMA Handbook, except those that are posted at the event or covered below.

1. There will be no hole shot area.
2. No pit bike riding.
3. A copy of the entrant's birth certificates for all youth riders must be sent in with the entry form. Birth Certificate copies will not be returned at the event.
4. Riders meeting will be at 5 pm Friday, August 14, 2009. All riders must attend to participate. Anyone not attending will be disqualified with no refund.
5. Rider entries will determine the run order. First entries received will be the last to run in each class. Last entries received will be the first to run in each class.
6. Trophies per class will be determined by the AMA Promoter Grand Championship agreement.
7. Hillclimb will start promptly at 8 am both Saturday and Sunday. You will need to be in assigned (entry) order to run, or you will forfeit your run for the day. There is a 2 minute limit to get into position and start your run up the hill or forfeit your run for the day.
8. All riders must bring their approved (full face) helmet to the inspection area Friday, August 14th, with their bike. Minimum 8 inch high boots and long sleeve shirt are also required to run.
9. Camping in authorized areas only.
10. No campfires. There will be a fire ring by the clubhouse for everyone's use. To stop the spread of disease and pests no firewood will be allowed to be brought in to the clubgrounds.
